MUSICAL THEATRE PROJECT

To wrap our unit on Musical Theatre, you will be required to imagine, create, and perform a brief musical theatre piece, demonstrating your understanding of the major components and influences in modern musical theatre.

This is considered your **Semester 1 Showcase Performance**, so please be reminded that it will heavily impact your grade in Theatre. *This will count as a Summative Assessment,* which means that this grade will count for 80%. It is extremely important that you not only focus on your own success, but the success of your group as well.

Performance Criteria:

You will be required to create a brief, original musical theatre piece inspired by a work of art. Your group should consider the following:

- A clearly defined story line.
- Your piece should be somewhere between 7-10 minutes in length.
- Evidence of carefully rehearsed and choreographed movement/dance. (All pieces should include a minimum of 1 minute of choreography.)
- Evidence of clear collaboration among ensemble members.
- Use of music to help accentuate the plot line.

Project Timeline:

 - o Introduction to project. Groups will work on finding and selecting an art piece as inspiration. Groups will also determine roles: composer, librettist, director, and choreographer.
